The forging industry will be recognized as the provider of highly valued products fueled by practical, applied research.


The forging industry will be more competitive by the transfer and deployment of innovative technologies.



# **EDUCATION**

# **Future Workforce Development**

FIERF's education services focus on university-based engineering programs to provide students with forging-related learning experiences and to encourage careers in forging and related industries. These activities promote an understanding of forging processes.

- FIERF Named Professor at Colorado School of Mines – The FIERF Professor promotes forging education throughout the academic community and leads FIA Die and Press Fundamentals training courses.
- Internship Program The Foundation acts as a clearing house for organizations seeking to hire an





interested Scholarship or Magnet School student as a summer intern.

- Research Grants The Foundation provides funding to engage students in forging-related research. These projects are reported out at the Industry Technical Conference, through webinars and are posted in the Technical Library.
- Forging Industry Scholarships –
   The Foundation awards up to 18 scholarships per year to the best and brightest engineering and business university students to encourage careers in the forging supply chain.
